Project Highlights

This project style is a combination between oriental architecture and modern interior, we tend to merge rough materials like beige matt travertine on external façade and internal walls with a glossy crema marfil and Light emperador marble on floors as solid surfaces, meanwhile the mixture of leather furniture and soft fabric cushions distributed here and there to soften the feeling of solidness around.





Paintings are customized specifically to this project to speak same oriental language of arches, patterns and metaphors. Arabic calligraphy was the main element of these paintings to emboss one of the most powerful elements in such a design.





Water fountains are used in square shapes in the centre of main entry hall which brings -as Feng Shui refers – a flow of Chi energy and healthy finances into user’s life. Also, it is used in main reception area where users could meet their friends and relatives, which thought to regenerate oneself spiritually and emotionally, and connect people to each other.
